


DRUNK DRIVING LIKELIHOOD BY AGE GROUP




ECONOMIC COST FOR MOTORVEHICLE CRASHES

The estimated economic cost of alcoholimpaired motor vehicle traffic crashes in the United States in 2010 was \$44 billion. Included in the economic costs are:

- Lost productivity
- Workplace losses
- Legal and court expenses
- Medical costs
- Emergency medical services
- Insurance administration
- Congestion
- Property damage


